FROM NEW YORK CITY

Deegan Expressway/New York State Thruway (I-87) north to exit 8. Right to Cross Westchester Expressway (I-287), east to Hutchinson River Parkway. North on Hutchinson River Parkway to exit 27 (in New York, not Connecticut) at Route 120 (Purchase Street). Left on Purchase Street to campus.

FROM LONG ISLAND

Throgs Neck or Whitestone Bridge north to Hutchinson River Parkway north to exit 27 (in New York, not Connecticut) at Route 120 (Purchase Street). Left on Purchase Street to campus.

FROM UPSTATE NEW YORK AND NORTHERN NEW JERSEY

Tappan Zee Bridge East to Cross Westchester Expressway (I-287). East to Hutchinson River Parkway (Exit 9 north). North on Hutchinson River Parkway to exit 27 (in New York, not Connecticut) at Route 120 (Purchase Street). Left on Purchase Street to campus.

FROM CONNECTICUT
